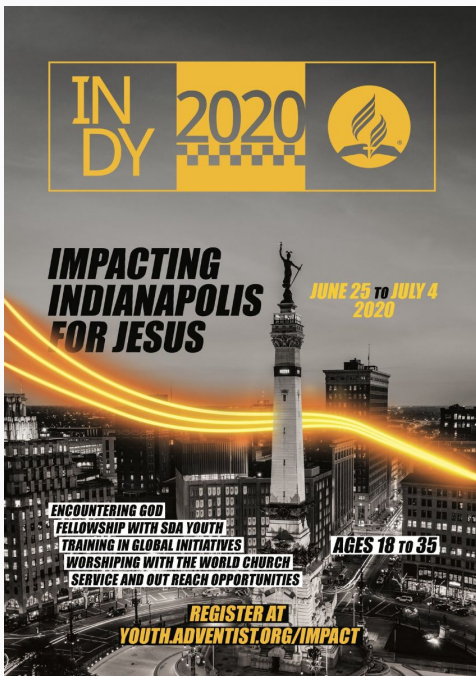

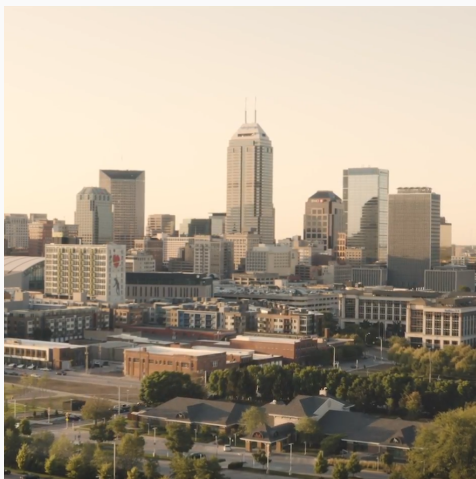

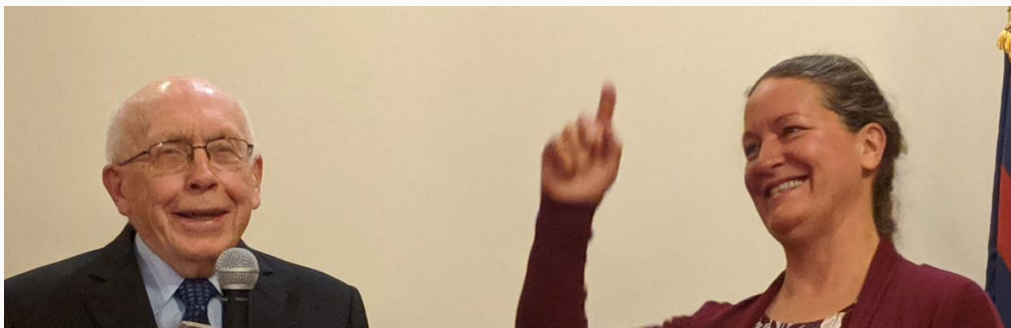

Baptism Seven Years in the Making
