Service was again held in the historic Waterloo Seventh-day Adventist Church near Cassville, Wisconsin, on July 17, 2021.

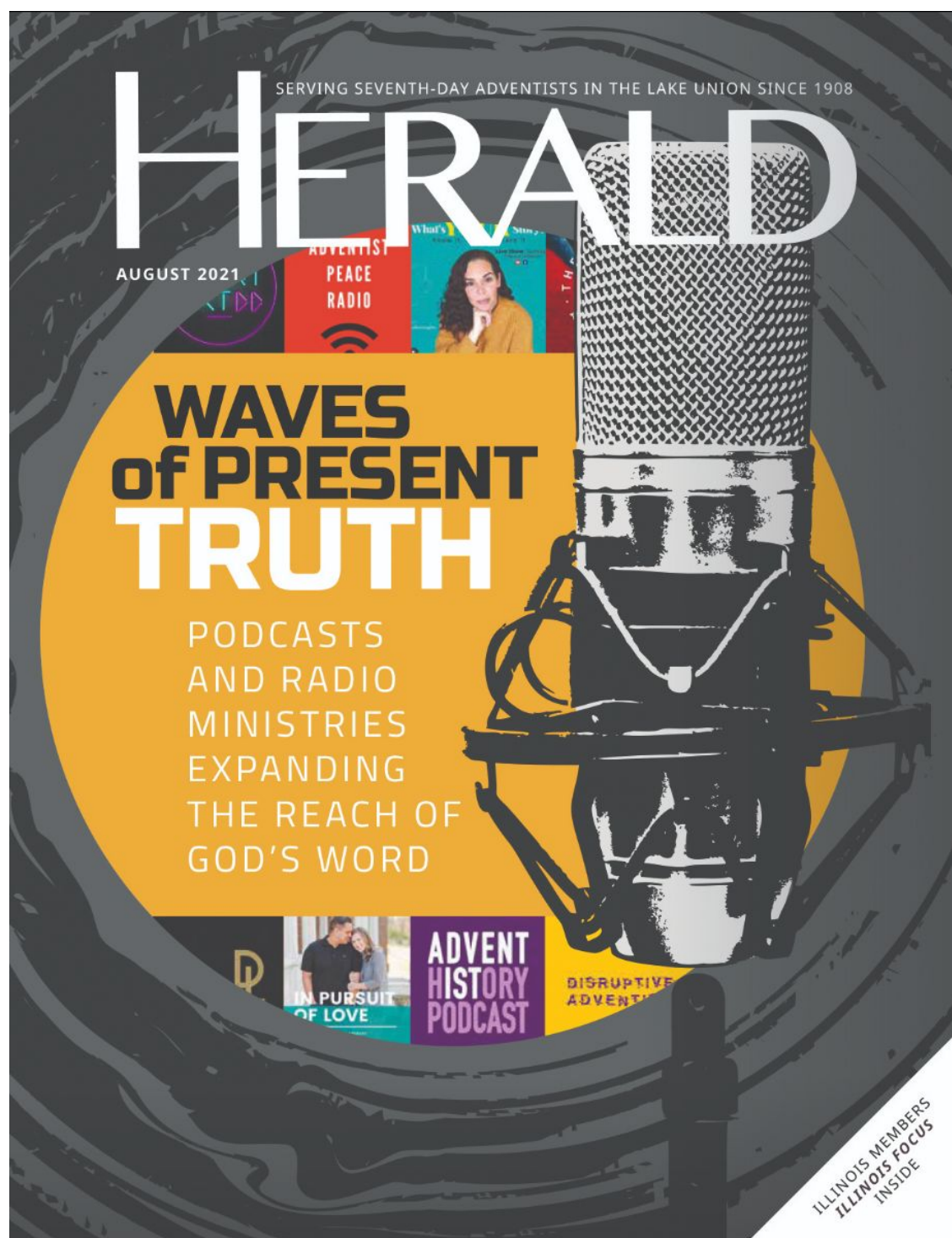

PROJECT SAFE CHURCH

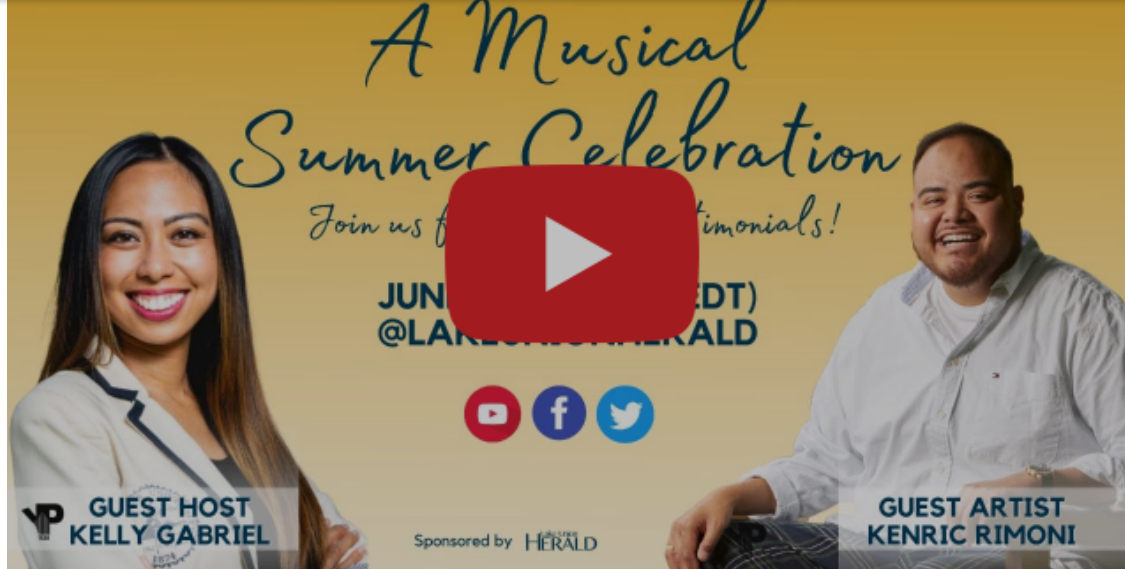
