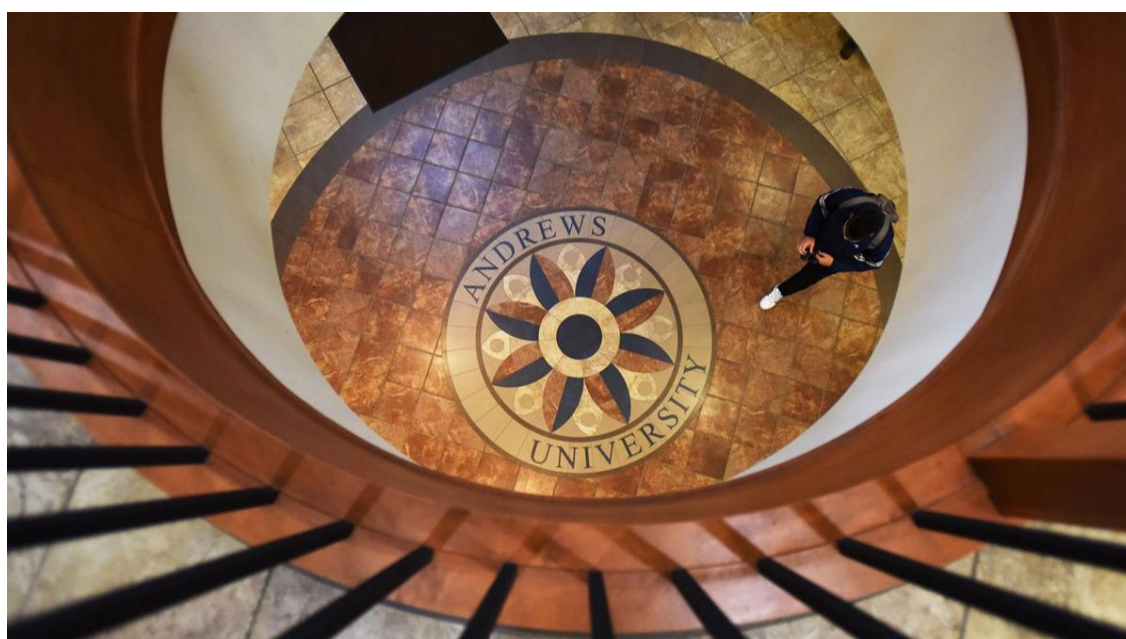

This week Zack Payne, Wisconsin youth director, visited Clear Lake, Wisc., to see the good work of Alice Garrett, Wisconsin Community Services director, and her team. Garrett and her team have been facilitating drives around the state to clothe 12,500 Afghan refugees at Fort McCoy.

"The facility there is just about done accepting clothing, because they will soon have enough for all refugees," says Payne. "Medical needs have also been met, praise God! Beyond that, the resettlement process will begin. 400 of these individuals will end up in Wisconsin and others will resettle in other states around the country."
