GREAT LAKES ADVENTIST ACADEMY RUNS TO AID ADOPTED ISLAND Students from Great Lakes Adventist Academy surpassed their fundraiser goal of \$2,500 and raised \$3,300 to help aid the Lake Union mission school in Kosrae. Students had about one month to reach their goal with a challenge for each individual student to raise at least \$15 on their own.

"The students were pumped," Cindy Peterson, Bible teacher and organizer for the Kosrae 5K Race said. "They went over and beyond the expectation and were excited to help the students in Kosrae."

On September 22nd, the forecast predicted rain but that didn't stop the race. "We

had about 180 participants from the academy and the community show up," said Peterson. "Surprisingly, the rain stopped for two hours while everyone was running! It was a perfect day!"

"We wanted to share the vision that gave birth to this event," said Jose Medina, Indiana Conference pastor, "which is a plead for unification at the next General Conference Session, as well as prayer for the upcoming evangelistic events taking place in Indiana."

As inspiration for the conference, organizers are calling attention to this quote from Ellen White's "Desire of Ages": As activity increases and men become successful in doing any work for God, there is danger of trusting to human plans and methods. There is a tendency to pray less, and to have less faith. Like the disciples, we are in danger of losing sight of our dependence on God, and seeking to make a savior of our activity. We need to look constantly to Jesus, realizing that it is His power which does the work. While we are to labor earnestly for the salvation of the lost, we must also take time for meditation, for prayer, and for the study of the word of God. Only the work accomplished with much prayer, and sanctified by the merit of Christ, will in the end prove to have been efficient for good. – {DA 362.2}
