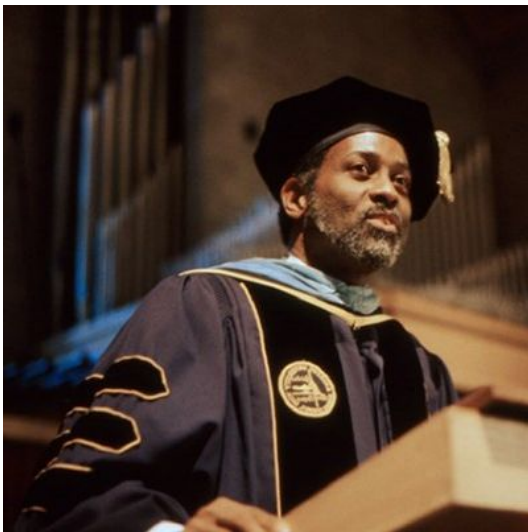

Educators participated in discussion groups, exploring ways schools can enhance cultures of wellness, and delving into how to develop and further strengthen STEM educational practices in both elementary and secondary classrooms. 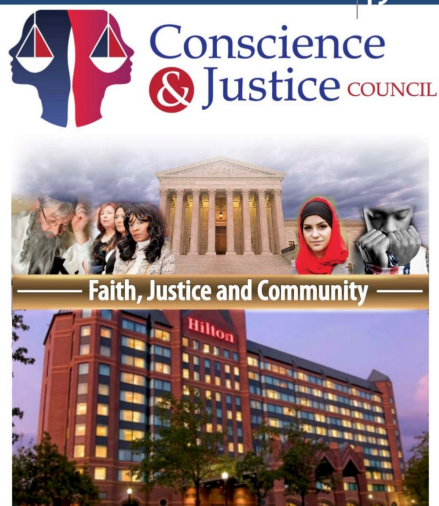

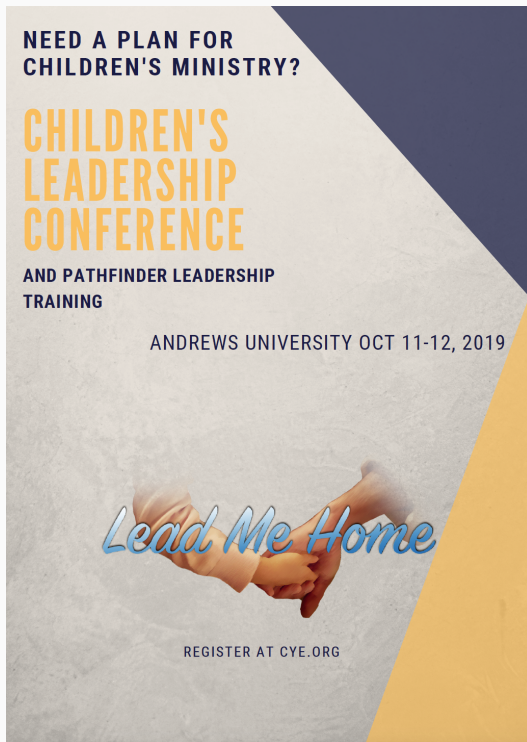

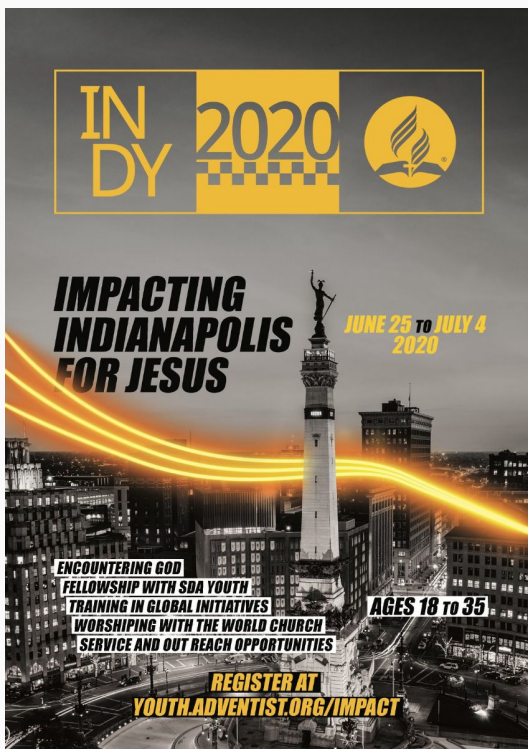
