

One hundred years ago this month, Adventists in the Lake Union prepared for Missionary Volunteer Society Week, over the week of March 18-25. For this week, special emphasis was placed on literature evangelism. Groups like the Battle Creek Tabernacle Literature Band (pictured in 1917) provided Missionary Volunteer leaflets, while prayer and personal work bands met daily. Ministry to young church members were the week's focus, as the Lake Union Herald explained on March 1: "It is the plan that our entire force of ministers and other workers, just as far as it can be consistently arranged, should make this week a special week of prayer and work for our children and youth." Missionary Volunteer Society Week was just one of many weeks of ministry emphasis planned for congregations throughout the year.
