

This Month in Adventist History



"On a snowy day in January in the 1940s, members of the Medical Cadet Corps (MCC) from across the Lake Union gathered at the Adventist campground at Grand Ledge, Michigan, for annual drills. The Grand Ledge campground served as the main training facility for the Lake Union's cadets for several decades, and January saw many annual gatherings. The MCC was founded by Everett N. Dick in 1934 on the campus of Union College in Lincoln, Nebraska. The MCC served as an alternative for young Adventists who wished to avoid combat in the armed services. By providing medical training prior to conscription, Adventists who were drafted into service were prepared to become medics rather than combatants."
