A scholarship that will provide free tuition to high school graduates in Grand Rapids to attend Grand Rapids Community College has been <u>approved</u>. The Michigan Treasury Department approved the Grand Rapids Promise Zone Scholarship and it will start with the class of 2020, including students from **Grand Rapids Adventist Academy**. The scholarship funds 60 credits, which is a two-year degree. Students can attend GRCC full-time or part time with the scholarship and have five years to complete their degree. The scholarship will also cover the cost of fees, books and required course materials. *Source*. <u>WZZM13</u>


